CHECK YOUR PASSPORT AND TRAVEL DOCUMENTS BEFORE YOU TRAVEL

PASSPORT VALIDITY:

our passport should be valid for a minimum period of 6 months from the date of entry into Brazil.

VISA REQUIREMENTS:

Holders of ordinary passports of the following countries do not require a visa to visit Brazil for up to 30 days:

Citizens from other countries must obtain a visit visa (VIVIS) in advance. Special attention to Endeavor Local Offices: Egypt, Jordan, Kenya, Lebanon, Nigeria, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia and Vietnam.

If you need a visa, you should look for the Brazilian Embassy in your country and start the visa procedure.

COVID PROTOCOL FOR ENTERING BRAZIL



Foreigners could be asked to present a proof of vaccination at land control points. You are considered vaccinated if all doses of a vaccine against SARS-Cov-2 have been administered for at least two weeks before traveling.

WHO-approved vaccines: AztraZeneca/Oxford, Johnson and Johnson, Moderna, Pfizer/BioTech, Sinopharm, Sinovac, Covaxin, Covovac, Nuvaxovid

São Paulo state no longer mandates the use of face masks and face coverings while in public. However, the guidance may vary until ISP dates. We recommend you bring your own supply of face masks in case they are needed. The Endeavor team will alert you if the use of masks becomes mandatory.

The use of a mask is recommended by WHO, especially for people with flu symptoms and for the most vulnerable public, such as immunocompromised, pregnant women and the elderly.

Other vaccine recommendations:

There is no obligation to show vaccine certificates, but Rabies, Tuberculosis (TB) and Yellow Fever vaccines are recommended for some travelers visiting Brazil.

ABOUT SÃO PAULO



The city of São Paulo is one of the most populous in the world and has a significant national and international influence in many aspects.

With several monuments and reference cultural spaces, such as Latin America Memorial or MASP, the city combines culture with spaces that meet nature through urban gardens and parks, such as Ibirapuera. 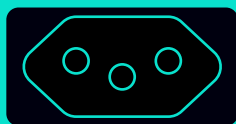
Time zone:

Brazil is one of the few countries that uses both 110 and 220 Volt.

You will find a type N 3 pin model as brazilian standard so we highly recommend bringing a Travel Adaptor.



TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS



All three hotel options are located in the heart of São Paulo, a few meters away from Paulista Avenue.

São Paulo has two main airports:

São Paulo International Airport (GRU) is located approximately 30 km (18 miles) from all hotel options (estimated fee: 40USD).

Domestic and regional flights are serviced through *Congonhas-São Paulo Airport (CGH)*, located approximately 10 km (5 miles) from all hotel options (estimated fee: 14USD).
