Once selected, these founders gain access to Endeavor's Global Network of Trust. Through curated introductions, mentorship, and peer-to-peer advice, they receive support at the pivotal moments of their scaling journey.

WE ELEVATE 36

As companies grow, founders step into a new role. They inspire, mentor, and invest in the next generation of entrepreneurs. Over time, they become Multipliers, key to accelerating the development of their communities.

WE INVEST 42

Through Endeavor Catalyst, we co-invest in the companies of Endeavor Entrepreneurs. The fund unlocks capital and connects global investors to high-growth companies emerging from Elsewhere, rebalancing the global flow of venture capital.

As these ecosystems grow, so do the stories emerging from them. Through Elsewhere, our global magazine, we advance the narrative about global entrepreneurship, shedding light on the stories, founders, and perspectives beyond the expected innovation hubs.

Letter from Linda

At Endeavor, we have always taken words seriously.

Perhaps it is not surprising that a similar sensitivity exists in my own home. Married to an author and raising two daughters who chose humanities over business school, I live in a house where language is constantly debated around our dinner table.

But in our work, the right words are also an important tool.

Since our earliest days in 1997, Endeavor has been anchored around a simple belief: talent is everywhere, but opportunity is not. Over the last 29 years, we have met extraordinary founders building world-class companies in places the tech world often overlooks. Outside Silicon Valley. Outside China. Outside the handful of ecosystems that dominated the conversation about entrepreneurship.

For a long time, the global innovation map has been drawn around only a few points. Attention and capital flowed toward those hubs again and again, reinforcing the idea that meaningful innovation could only originate in predetermined places.

Yet the founders we were meeting every year told a different story.

Today, Endeavor has selected more than 3,000 entrepreneurs, including over 100 unicorn founders, showcasing that extraordinary companies can emerge from far more places than the traditional narrative suggests. The talent was always there. What was missing was visibility.

That realization led us to a new word: Elsewhere.

Elsewhere is how we describe the parts of the innovation map that have too often been left blank: markets frequently overlooked by global capital, even as founders there are solving systemic problems across borders.

Elsewhere is where four fintech co-founders are processing nearly 3% of Venezuela's GDP with Cashea. Where two founders in Puerto Rico are applying stablecoins to navigate unstable economies with Rain. Where a founder from Khartoum left her legal career in the UK to return to Sudan and start Cashi to build financial infrastructure while navigating blackouts, displacement, and a collapsing financial system. And where a Ukrainian entrepreneur scaling the global microlearning app Headway moved back from London to Kyiv after the full-scale invasion to be closer to his team.

Stories like these remind us that innovation has never belonged to a single place—expanding the map matters.

Today, Endeavor Entrepreneurs are building companies across more than 100 countries, connected through our global network of trust. Mentors and peers from different industries and backgrounds support them to scale beyond borders without leaving their ecosystems behind. To support their global ambition, our new Global Hubs in London, the UAE, Singapore, San Francisco/Silicon Valley, and New York connect founders with capital, talent, and markets around the world.

Endeavor Catalyst, our rules-based co-investment fund, has made nearly 400 investments in companies from Elsewhere. As we launch Fund V in May 2026, we believe the venture capital map will increasingly follow the innovation map.

In the pages that follow, I invite you to look beyond the familiar headlines. Far more is happening than the traditional map suggests.

Innovation comes from Elsewhere.

WE SELECT

We select Endeavor Entrepreneurs by scouring the globe for talent, identifying founders with the greatest growth potential, and inviting them to participate in our renowned selection journey.

The Rebirth of an Old Country

In September 2025, up-and-coming founders from all over the world flew to Cambridge, UK. There, they participated in the final stage of Endeavor's rigorous selection process: the International Selection Panel (ISP). Ultimately, only 1% of candidates are chosen to become Endeavor Entrepreneurs. By the time these companies reach the ISP, the level of quality is outstanding.

Four of those aspiring candidates were Pedro Vallenilla, Ramón Lange, Nicolás Curat, and Arnoldo Gabaldón, the co-founders of Cashea, a Buy Now Pay Later (BNPL) fintech company. When Cashea first launched its app in Venezuela in 2022, the market's reaction was a dramatic silence, with no downloads and no transactions. The co-founders realized their problem—they'd been searching for an online customer base, when most of their customers were offline. They decided to pivot to deploying in-store ambassadors to onboard customers and merchants in order to grow a client base. The results have been dramatic: Cashea is now the largest provider of consumer credit in Venezuela and the biggest BNPL player in Latin America, processing transactions equivalent to 3% of Venezuela's GDP. "Cashear," meaning "to use Cashea's financing product," has become an everyday Spanish neologism in the country.

At the ISP, Cashea's founders sat across the table from Mariano Gomide, the co-founder and co-CEO of Brazilian multinational cloud commerce company VTEX and an Endeavor Entrepreneur since 2018. "This company is Endeavor materialized," Mariano marvelled. "It's everything Endeavor stands for. There is a political aspect we can't take out of it.

They represent more than just a company, but the rebirth of an old country." Following multiple interviews with our panelists, including Mariano, Cashea's co-founders were selected as Endeavor Entrepreneurs, and Cashea became the first Venezuelan company in our community, setting new standards for entrepreneurial success in Elsewhere markets.

Incorporating Endeavor Entrepreneurs into the selection process for new founders has always been part of our model. But in 2025, we reached a new milestone: 50% of all panelists were Endeavor Entrepreneurs. Among the CEOs, industry leaders, mentors, and VCs that form Endeavor's network, these leaders offer a special level of insight—they've tackled similar problems, built successful companies in similar underserved markets, and know the exact power and potential of finding a great solution Elsewhere. They understand what it takes to succeed as an Endeavor Entrepreneur and the value of the mentorship and support they have received themselves.

But this community also reflects the growing success of Elsewhere markets. ISP panelists should be respected and expert leaders in their field, ready to select the next generation of founders. Many Endeavor Entrepreneurs have already reached these heights only a few years after their own selection journey. Now, they're leading others through the same journey, welcoming a new generation of founders to this network of trust that's changing the entrepreneurial game in underserved regions.

WHERE SELECTION COMES TO LIFE: INTRODUCING DEXORY

Andrei, Adrian, and Oana met in school in Romania, moved to the UK to become housemates, and started building robots. They made a plan to build an autonomous data-collecting robot for customer interaction in retail, but the COVID-19 pandemic drew their attention to a greater issue. Disrupted supply chains led the founders to recognize the urgent need for efficiency in logistics and warehouse operations. In 2023, they launched Dexory as it is today: a full-stack solution that embraces automation and AI to redefine the future of logistics.

1 First Opinion Review

Endeavor staff conduct interviews with companies to assess candidates' viability.

2 Second Opinion Review

Endeavor mentors conduct multiple interviews, probing on business strategy, innovation, growth potential, and founders' personal qualities, while also providing feedback.

3 Local Selection Panel

The penultimate step of the journey: mentors, entrepreneurs, and board members interview and ultimately vote whether to proceed with candidates at a panel run by our in-market team.

4 International Selection Panel

Global business leaders and top Endeavor Entrepreneurs serve as panelists to interview finalist candidates. Only unanimously selected candidates will become Endeavor Entrepreneurs.

The Criteria for Selection

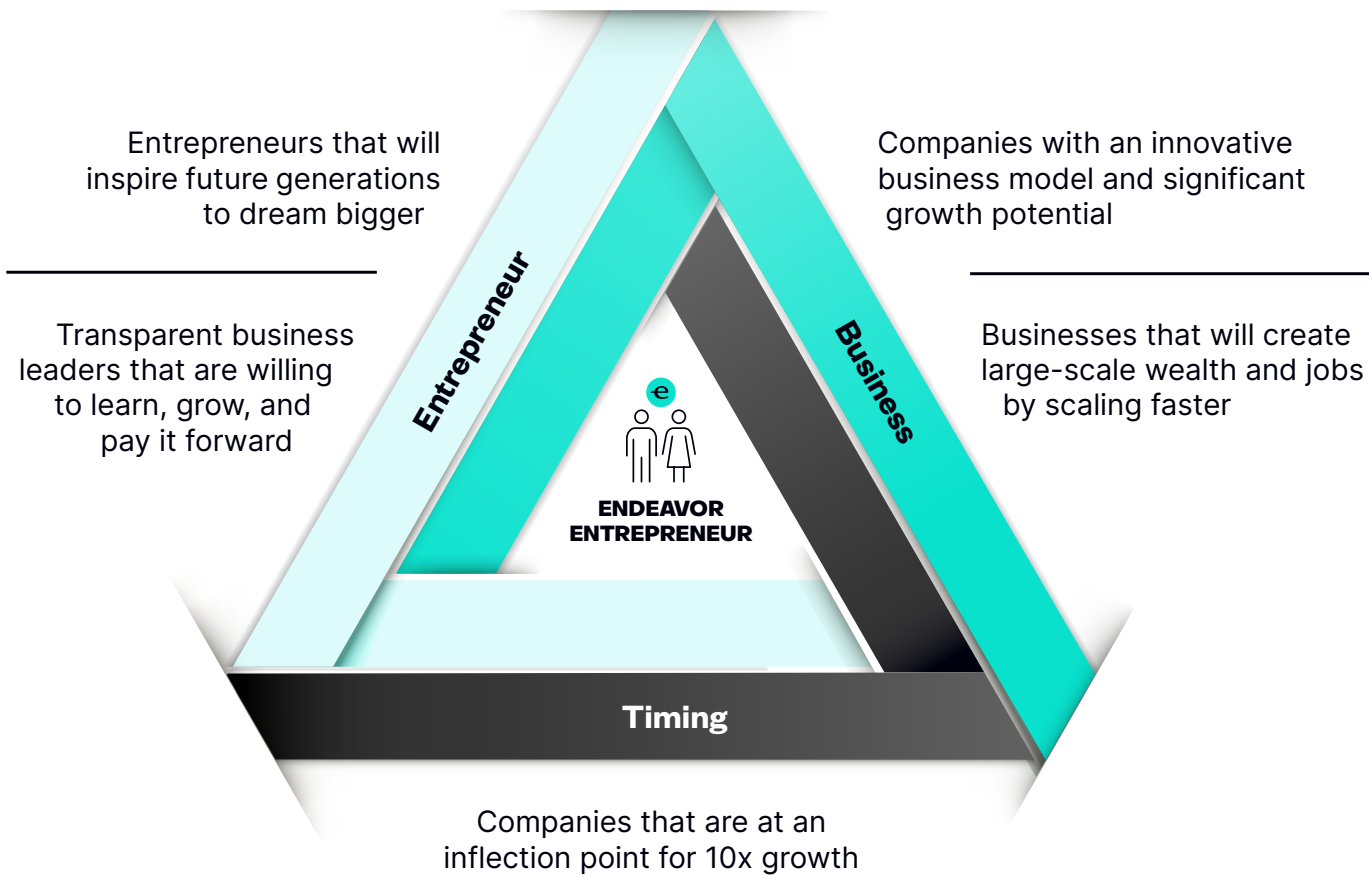
When you expand your vision to look beyond the typical centers of entrepreneurship, as we do every day at Endeavor, you'll notice a particular trend: amazing entrepreneurs are everywhere. Where governments fail and economies slump, entrepreneurs step up. Where underserved countries face complex issues, entrepreneurs come up with unique solutions. And the best entrepreneurs have an outsized impact, becoming role models and shaping the future of their ecosystems.

So how do we choose the right entrepreneurs to join Endeavor — founders who have not just the ideas, but the ability to see them through to scale and global success? Founders who won't just change a company, but a whole

country or continent? Since 1997, when we selected our first Endeavor Entrepreneur, we've had a three-pronged approach: entrepreneur, business, and timing. The entrepreneur at the center of the idea is crucial. We don't want just a great idea or a competent CEO, but someone who is going to inspire generations of founders to come. We look for ambition, transparency, openness, and capability. We also consider the business itself: will it scale fast enough to create large-scale wealth and jobs? Does it have the numbers to back the vision? And is the business ready to scale tenfold?

Only when all three sides of the triangle are complete do we know we're speaking to an Endeavor Entrepreneur.

In 2025, we selected over 80 companies and 150 entrepreneurs. Let's take a close-up look to see how a few amongst them embodied our selection criteria.

1. Entrepreneur



VAMMO

Co-founders Jack Sarvary and Billy Blaustein are examples of the entrepreneurial peer network in action. Billy spent time at Uber and Tesla, launching Uber in Mexico and Brazil as the first employee in the region, while Jack is an alum of another Endeavor Entrepreneur-led company: Colombian giant Rappi. Together, they founded Vammo, an electric mobility platform for professional couriers, which has already raised \$34M since 2022.

TALA

Shivani Siroya grew up between India and the United States. After starting her career in investment banking, she joined the United Nations Population Fund, where she worked across nine countries in West and Sub-Saharan Africa, interviewing thousands about their financial lives. These conversations shaped Tala. Since launching in Kenya in 2014, the company has expanded to the Philippines and Mexico, using AI and alternative data to extend credit to underserved communities. Today, Tala reaches over 11 million customers, building financial access at scale across emerging markets.



2. Business



RAIN

Stablecoins had a big year in 2025 and have been picked by the Endeavor Catalyst team as a trend to watch. One of the most recognized companies in stablecoin infrastructure today is Rain, a financial infrastructure company founded in New York City and selected by Endeavor Puerto Rico. Rain offers stablecoin-backed Visa credit cards, giving users the option to use stablecoins for everyday purchases. They've started 2026 with a bang, announcing a \$250M Series C, bringing the company's valuation to a staggering \$1.95B.

MAYBELL QUANTUM

The product at the heart of this Denver-based company sounds like something out of science fiction: a Big Fridge, roughly 270 times colder than deep space and 200,000 times colder than the coldest temperature ever recorded on Earth. The Maybell Quantum Big Fridge is made for laboratories, to enable quantum computing and offer new opportunities for scientific study, with only one-tenth of the carbon footprint of typical dilution refrigerators.



RABBIT

By the time Rabbit and Endeavor crossed paths, the delivery company had already built up an impressive record in Egypt, where it was founded, specializing in delivering groceries and other essentials within 20 minutes. But they were about to take a big step: launching in Saudi Arabia at the same time that they went to their ISP in Dubai. The timing was right for a boost of the Endeavor effect.



3. Timing

MAISA

For artificial intelligence to reach its potential in increasing productivity, there need to be applications, built on top of the model layer, that are capable of doing actual work — and that enterprises can trust. Maisa is an application-layer platform that deploys reliable, auditable AI agents across regulated industries such as banking, energy, and manufacturing. Built out of Spain, Maisa raised a \$25M Seed Round led by Creandum and Forgepoint — the largest seed round in the country's history.

Selection as a Service

This year's new Endeavor Entrepreneurs showcase the breadth and depth of global talent from an already-scaled Nigerian-born mobility infrastructure company (Moove), to a fast-growing Ukrainian full-stack payments platform founded in 2016 (Solidgate).

"Our goals in Selection are simple," says Evan Bullington, Endeavor's Head of Entrepreneur Selection. "We want to demonstrate the power of the Endeavor network to the candidates, and we want to keep our bar high for who we call Endeavor Entrepreneurs. With every interaction, our goal is always to put exactly the right mentor on the other side of the table for an entrepreneur, both in terms of helping us get to the right outcomes and based on what challenges the entrepreneurs are currently facing."

This mindset is part of the reason why we were so excited to see so many Endeavor Entrepreneurs joining the ISP process as panelists in 2025. Who better to advise candidates on next steps, and who better to show the momentum and support Endeavor provides, than people

who have previously been through the process? "I tend to be head-down building and don't spend much time talking to other founders," one candidate said. "Often we think our challenges are unique to our company—but they're not. [The Endeavor ISP was] useful to contextualize those challenges and hear how others solved them. Some of the tactical advice I found to be very good and immediately applicable."

As for the panelists sitting on the other side of the table, their primary concern was how to push these new founders to reach new heights. Insights from their discussions included questions such as: How can we support them at this pivotal moment? What would it take for this company to become one of the highest-performing companies in our network within two years? And how do we help them scale not 10x, but 100x?

We're excited to see where our new Endeavor Entrepreneurs go. And we hope that in a few years, they'll find themselves sitting back at the ISP, evaluating new founders and growing our network of trust.

DIASPORA FOUNDERS

Building Elsewhere, Giving Back Home.

When Endeavor was founded in 1997, entrepreneurs were mainly focused on their local markets: Brazilians building businesses from Brazil, Mexicans building in Mexico, Indonesians in Indonesia. But those days are long gone.

We now connect founders from all over the world with Endeavor offices in the countries they're in. This way, exceptional diaspora founders have a chance to multiply their impact back home: they become role models who actively reinvest, mentor, and transfer a global perspective back into their local ecosystems. Their capital, time, credibility, and pattern recognition flow back to the next generation of founders, creating a pathway between their original ecosystems and global success. After forging that path, who better to offer fellow founders a map than those who walked it first?

Runway

In 2018, three NYU Tisch students founded a company that would unite art and science—AI unicorn Runway. Led by Cristóbal Valenzuela and Alejandro Matamala from Chile and Anastasis Germanidis from Greece, Runway uses cutting-edge AI models to create generative videos and images and has contributed to films and TV, including Everything Everywhere All at Once and The Late Show with Stephen Colbert.

Preply

Preply, an AI-powered online language learning platform headquartered in Barcelona, Spain, has deep roots in Ukraine, where its co-founders and friends Kirill Bigai and Dmytro Voloshyn originate from. The company unites human and AI education, with a global network of 100,000 tutors teaching over 90 languages with AI-powered tools, and has become a category leader and the largest online marketplace featuring human tutors.

Reflection AI

Founded in 2024, Reflection AI is building open-source foundation models designed to rival closed labs like OpenAI and Anthropic, giving developers and companies greater control, transparency, and flexibility in how they build with AI. In October, the company raised \$2B at an \$8B valuation — a 15x leap from its previous \$545M valuation just seven months earlier. Co-Founder and CTO Ioannis Antonoglou, a Greek immigrant based in New York City, became an Endeavor Entrepreneur in 2025.



WE SUPPORT

We support Endeavor Entrepreneurs by providing access to global markets, capital, and highly curated connections with peers and innovators who have navigated similar pivotal moments.

Getting selected is just the beginning.

When founders join Endeavor, they enter a global community of entrepreneurs who have built ambitious companies from places the world often overlooks. Every founder carries different challenges—fundraising rounds that need to close; a market they have never operated in; a leadership team that suddenly has to evolve faster than the company itself.

We sit with founders in these moments. We ask the hard questions early: Where is the company stuck? Are there any decisions coming that cannot be undone? What kind of support will actually move the needle?

Entering a new market, raising or structuring capital, navigating leadership transitions, responding to a crisis, or defining a path to liquidity can define the path of a company scaling up.

Our global support network is designed to activate precisely at these moments. Rather than offering one-size-fits-all services, Endeavor mobilizes mentors, peers, and investors to help founders make better, more confident choices when it matters most.

Across 2025, we saw how timely, global connections helped founders unlock growth, speed, and scale in ways possible only within a network built on trust.

One year, an entrepreneur reaches \$100M in revenue or expands across markets. The next, they're navigating new expectations, increasingly complex teams, and a growing number of people all pulling them in different directions. The challenge shifts from building the business to scaling yourself alongside it.

At this stage, having mentors and peers is essential. We hear founders across markets describe their journey in the same way: both exhilarating and isolating. The decisions get heavier. The circle of people who truly understand gets smaller.

WHERE IT COMES TO LIFE: EXECUTIVE EDUCATION

Sometimes, the most valuable move is to step away from the company long enough to see it clearly again. In executive education programs at Harvard, Stanford, MIT, and Oxford, founders sit alongside peers facing similar inflection points, comparing notes on leadership, decision-making, and what comes next.

PIVOTAL MOMENT

Talent & Governance

As companies grow, complexity becomes the new challenge. What works through instinct, proximity, and founder intuition begins to strain under scale. Teams expand across markets, new leaders join, and decisions that were once immediate now require structure. Growth brings opportunity, but it also demands a different kind of organization.

For many founders, this stage is less visible than fundraising or expansion, but remains just as pivotal. The question shifts from how to build fast to how to build sustainably. Leadership teams need clearer roles, culture must travel across geographies, and governance becomes a way to protect momentum rather than slow it down. Scaling talent and structure is often when a company transitions from founder-driven to truly enduring.

PIVOTAL MOMENT

Growth

Growth rarely follows a straight line. The product that unlocks early traction is often not the one that carries a company into its next chapter. As markets mature, founders face a different question: how to keep evolving without losing focus. Expansion can mean entering new geographies, launching new product lines, or rethinking the business model altogether. Each move brings opportunity, but also risk.

At this stage, speed alone is not enough. Companies that have already scaled must learn how to reinvent parts of themselves while still performing at an accelerated pace. The challenge becomes balancing exploration with execution, deciding where to double down and where to adapt. These moments test judgment as much as ambition, especially when the next leap requires building something new on top of what already works.

WHERE IT COMES TO LIFE:
DUBAI FORWARD

During our inaugural Dubai Forward, Endeavor Entrepreneurs came together to explore expansion pathways, meet regional partners, and understand how new ecosystems can accelerate their next phase of scale. Through closed-door conversations and peer exchanges, founders examined how to position their companies beyond their home markets and discussed what it takes to grow in more complex environments.

PIVOTAL MOMENT

Capital & Finance

At a certain stage, capital stops being only fuel for growth and becomes a strategic decision about the future of the company. Founders who once focused on simply raising the next round begin weighing much bigger questions: Who are the right partners? How does timing shape valuation? What does liquidity mean for employees and early investors? And how do today's financial decisions define long-term control and optionality?

These choices are rarely straightforward. Raising capital can open new markets, accelerate product expansion, or enable acquisitions, but can also introduce pressure and tradeoffs. At the same time, conversations about liquidity start to surface, often earlier than founders expect. IPOs, secondaries, or M&A decisions carry personal, investor, and company implications that go far beyond numbers. The challenge becomes navigating both sides of the equation: securing capital to grow while thinking clearly about the future.



WHERE IT COMES TO LIFE: ACCESS TO CAPITAL

Securing the right partners and the right valuation can make or break a company, shaping its trajectory for years to come. As Endeavor's portfolio has become more global and more scaled, the caliber of capital support has evolved alongside it. In 2025, founders preparing to raise considered positioning, timing, and investor fit with tailored guidance, hands-on support, and the kind of "if not for Endeavor" introductions that rarely happen otherwise. Our focus was not only on accessing capital, but on helping founders approach fundraising with clarity and confidence at a moment when the stakes are highest.

WHERE IT COMES TO LIFE: PATH TO LIQUIDITY OUTLIERS PROGRAM

Another defining moment arrives when founders begin to think seriously about liquidity. After years spent building a company, focus turns to how personal and investor priorities align, and which path creates the strongest future for the company. IPOs, acquisitions, and secondary transactions are not just financial decisions. They are moments that shape ownership, leadership, and long-term ambition.

These conversations can feel isolating, especially because there is rarely only one right answer. In 2025, we facilitated focused peer groups and mentorship conversations to help Outliers explore liquidity options openly, pressure-test assumptions, and learn from others navigating similar decisions. The goal was not to push toward a specific outcome, but to create space for clearer thinking before committing to irreversible paths.

Founder Support

As companies scale, the challenges founders face become harder to share. The stakes are higher, the decisions carry second- and third-order consequences, and the circle of people who truly understand the trade-offs gets smaller. Success can look outwardly clear while internally feeling complex. Many founders describe this stage as paradoxical: being surrounded by teams and investors, yet carrying decisions that feel deeply solitary.

Peer support becomes essential precisely because it is rare. The value comes from conversations with others who have lived through similar moments, people who understand not only the strategy but also the emotional weight. These exchanges create space to speak candidly about leadership challenges, pressure-test ideas, and reconnect with the personal side of building at scale.

WHERE IT COMES TO LIFE: OUTLIERS CLASS OF 2025

1. The bar keeps rising

Compared to the first Outliers class in 2020, this year's group has accelerated dramatically. The number of companies generating \$100M+ in annual revenue has grown fourfold, median revenue across the class has nearly tripled, and the number of billion-dollar companies grew from 13 to 80, showing how quickly global ambition is compounding across ecosystems.

2. Success is more durable

Outliers are not just growing faster; they are sustaining performance longer. The average Outlier company is older today than in 2020, and 50 companies in 2025's class have held Outlier status since 2020, proving that endurance and reinvention matter as much as speed.

3. They're paving the way for others

Many Outliers are the first of their kind, opening doors for entire ecosystems. Fourteen companies in the 2025 class are the first unicorns in their countries, creating pathways for others to follow. As global investors enter new markets through these companies, each success becomes a signal that reshapes expectations and attracts more capital.



WHERE IT COMES TO LIFE: OUTLIERS CLASS OF 2025

The Outliers Retreat creates space for founders outside of execution. Away from meetings, metrics, and daily urgency, they step back to reflect on the decisions that shape the next chapter of their companies. A small group of Endeavor's top founders come together at moments of inflection, whether navigating new market realities, major strategic shifts, or questions about legacy and long-term direction.

What makes the experience different is the quality of the room. Conversations are founder-led, grounded in lived experience, and built on trust. The goal is not to present or perform, but to think together, candidly, about the challenges that only emerge at this level of scale.

The Multiplier Effect in action

When an entrepreneur trains, mentors, and invests in the next generation of founders, they multiply their impact. From job creation to innovation to community transformation, here's how we watched the Multiplier Effect of Endeavor Entrepreneurs play out this year.

TRAIN & INSPIRE

Ivy League degrees are great. Traditional credentials are fun. But more and more, what actually moves the needle on both success and respect for founders is experience within another fast-growing, successful company. We analyzed 200 unicorn founders in both the US and emerging markets: Only 20% had worked for a big consulting firm or MAMAA company (Meta, Apple, Microsoft, Amazon, Alphabet) and a third graduated from an elite university, but nearly half had worked for a startup or scaleup before.

It's why we see "founder factories": companies where employees learn what works in strategy, culture, and operations, then spiral off to found new companies of their own. Enterprise software solution Telerik saw Bulgaria's largest exit, then seeded nearly 40 new ventures by ex-employees. Ride-hailing giant Careem was the Middle East's first unicorn — and over 300 Careem alumni went on to form their own companies. And Colombian super app Rappi has seen former employees launch more than 130 companies. Because when you see others do it well, you know you can do it yourself.

MENTOR

Sometimes you need the perspective of someone who's been in your shoes: turning experience into advantage. When Argentine software company Globant received a compelling offer to sell in 2007, co-founders Martín Migoya, Guibert Englebienne, Martín Umanan, and Néstor Nocetti asked Endeavor mentor and Harvard professor Bill A. Sahlman for his thoughts.

After hearing about Globant's growth and customer base, Bill asked, "Why are you trying to sell? This is great, just keep it to yourselves." Globant's founders did — and seven years later, they went public on the NYSE at a \$400M valuation. Now with a market cap of \$2.6B, Globant employs over 30,000 people in 35 countries, while its founders mentor others standing at their own crossroads.

INVEST

Great founders remember where they came from, and keep capital — and conviction — at home. In underserved regions, institutional capital might still be hesitant, and founder-investors don't just fill a financial gap or provide the living proof that successful companies can come from anywhere. Instead, they grow confidence within the ecosystem by betting on it.

As success Elsewhere grows, we're seeing liquidity events making it more common for founders to fuel angel rounds, accelerators, and strategic acquisitions. In our own venture capital arm Endeavor Catalyst, about 30% of our Limited Partners are Endeavor Entrepreneurs. Some have gone on to start their own VC firms, like Kaszek (founded by Mercado Libre's Hernán Kazah and Nicolás Szekasy), Latitud (by VivaReal's Brian Requarth), Yellow VC (by Glovo's Oscar Pierre), and Init-6 (by Bukalapak's Achmad Zaky).

New Ways to Pay It Forward

Mentoring, investing, training, and inspiring are the standard pieces of a founder's Multiplier Effect. But, like entrepreneurs themselves, the metrics of impact continue to evolve. Here are three new ways Endeavor Entrepreneurs are reinvesting their success:

DIASPORA FOUNDERS

Diaspora founders may be living abroad, but they've never forgotten their roots. For example, in London we have 80+ Endeavor Entrepreneurs working actively to invest in their home ecosystems, including founders from ElevenLabs (Poland), Proximie (Lebanon), Dexory (Romania), Moniepoint (Nigeria) and InstaDeep (Tunisia).

ENDEAVOR ENTREPRENEUR TO BOARD MEMBER

There's nothing like being an Endeavor Entrepreneur to feel the impact and power of our global network — and so it's no surprise that many Endeavor Entrepreneurs go on to closer involvement with our future and strategy by serving as board members of our Endeavor offices.

BOTH SIDES OF THE ISP

The International Selection Panel (ISP) is the culmination of months of hard work as founders apply to become Endeavor Entrepreneurs. A panel of experts assesses our candidates on every part of their business, their strategy, and their own perspective as founders. In 2025, 50% of all expert panelists were themselves Endeavor Entrepreneurs who had once sat on the other side of the table, and who understood intimately the challenges of scaling companies in Elsewhere markets.

WE INVEST

We invest in Endeavor Entrepreneur-led companies with Endeavor Catalyst.

Endeavor Catalyst is the global investment fund of Endeavor. We back Endeavor Entrepreneur-led companies *Elsewhere*, markets outside Silicon Valley and China where entrepreneurial talent is abundant, but global support is not. Endeavor Catalyst has three primary goals: to financially support the companies of Endeavor Entrepreneurs, generate competitive returns, and make Endeavor financially self-sustaining through our pioneering 50/50 profit-sharing model.

Our Investment Approach:

We follow a rules-based co-investment approach with consistent guiding principles.

1 We invest in Endeavor Entrepreneur-led companies (up to 10% of the round, max \$2M)

2 raising equity rounds of \$5M+

3 led by a qualified institutional investor.

APPROACHING 400 INVESTMENTS

2025 was a big year for us, both in terms of the number of investments and capital deployed. We invested approximately \$70M into 50 new companies in 2025.

Launching With Endeavor Catalyst's Support — Again

As Endeavor Entrepreneurs continue their entrepreneurial journeys, many are launching new ventures — and we are backing them again. In 2025, approximately 19% of our investments were in subsequent companies founded by existing Endeavor Entrepreneurs.

In Brazil, Benjamin Gleason, an Endeavor Entrepreneur through his fintech company GuiaBolso, joined forces with Gonzalo Parejo Navajas to create Kamino, a financial management platform for SMBs.

In 2018, Endeavor Entrepreneur Jason Wenk (pictured to the right) founded Altruist, an all-in-one digital platform for independent financial advisors, now valued at \$1B+. In 2025, he drew on his expertise in the RIA market to build Prelude, an AI-native platform for asset management.

Based in Spain, Pablo Fernandez first built Clicars, an e-commerce platform for used cars, and then Clikalia, a proptech company in which we invested. Now he's turned his attention to Clidrive, an AI-powered car financing platform we expect to invest in soon.



INVESTMENT SPOTLIGHT

A Polish AI Unicorn

If you don't already know ElevenLabs, you've probably heard them. The Polish-based company has used their suite of Voice AI products to deliver speeches in the United States Congress, partner with governments to research AI security, provide customer support for major global companies, and more. In 2025, Endeavor Catalyst participated in their \$180M Series C led by a16z and ICONIQ Growth. Since then, the company has only grown more — in fact, they announced a \$500M Series D at an \$11B valuation in February 2026.

WHAT'S NEXT?

Global Venture Capital Trends to Watch

The Endeavor Catalyst team has a unique viewpoint on what venture capital trends will shape entrepreneurial ambition over the next year. Here's what they have their eye on:

Stablecoins thrive where currencies fail: Our founder and CEO, Linda Rottenberg, has long said that when economies turn down, entrepreneurs turn up. Emerging markets are driving global stablecoin adoption, fueled by inefficient financial systems and volatile currencies. Our portfolio reflects this broader trend with companies like Rain (Puerto Rico), Zar (Pakistan), and Zone (Nigeria), among others.

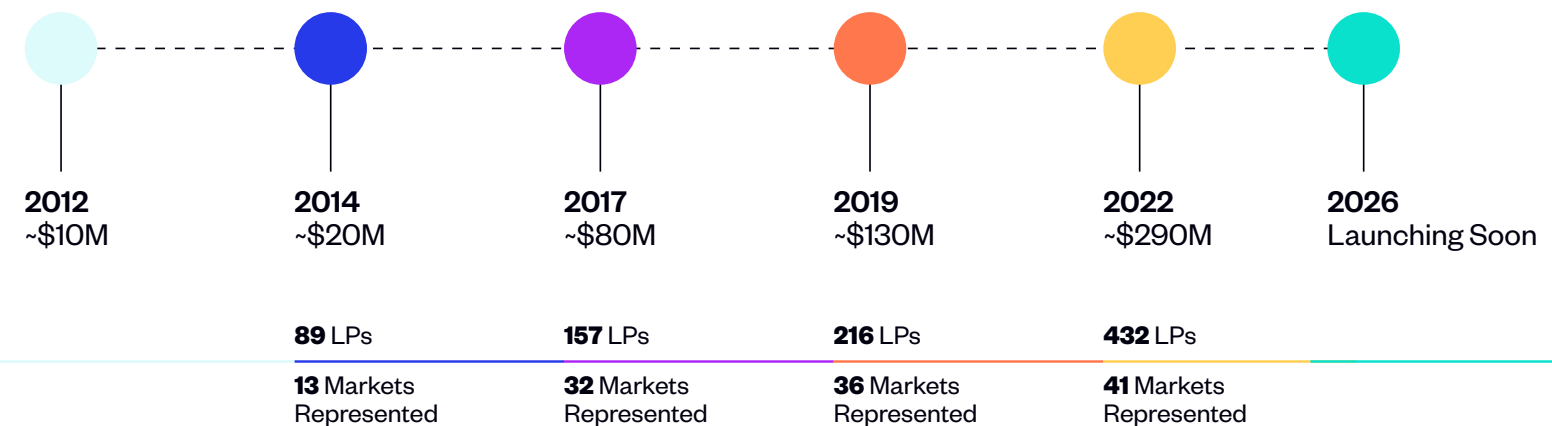
Look to Latin America for liquidity: Latin America's ecosystem is maturing rapidly, with 39 unicorns (nearly three times as many

as in 2020) and more than 60 tech companies that have raised \$150M+ but have yet to exit. Late-stage activity is expected to remain strong as companies await more favorable market conditions, so this trend surely will continue.

Saudi Arabia is reshaping the Middle East: Driven by Vision 2030, a government initiative to transition from oil dependency to innovation-led growth, a surge of entrepreneurial momentum is visible across the MENA region. Fast-growing startups like Unifonic have launched their own venture arms and are re-investing in the local entrepreneurial ecosystem, ensuring that the growth cycle continues.

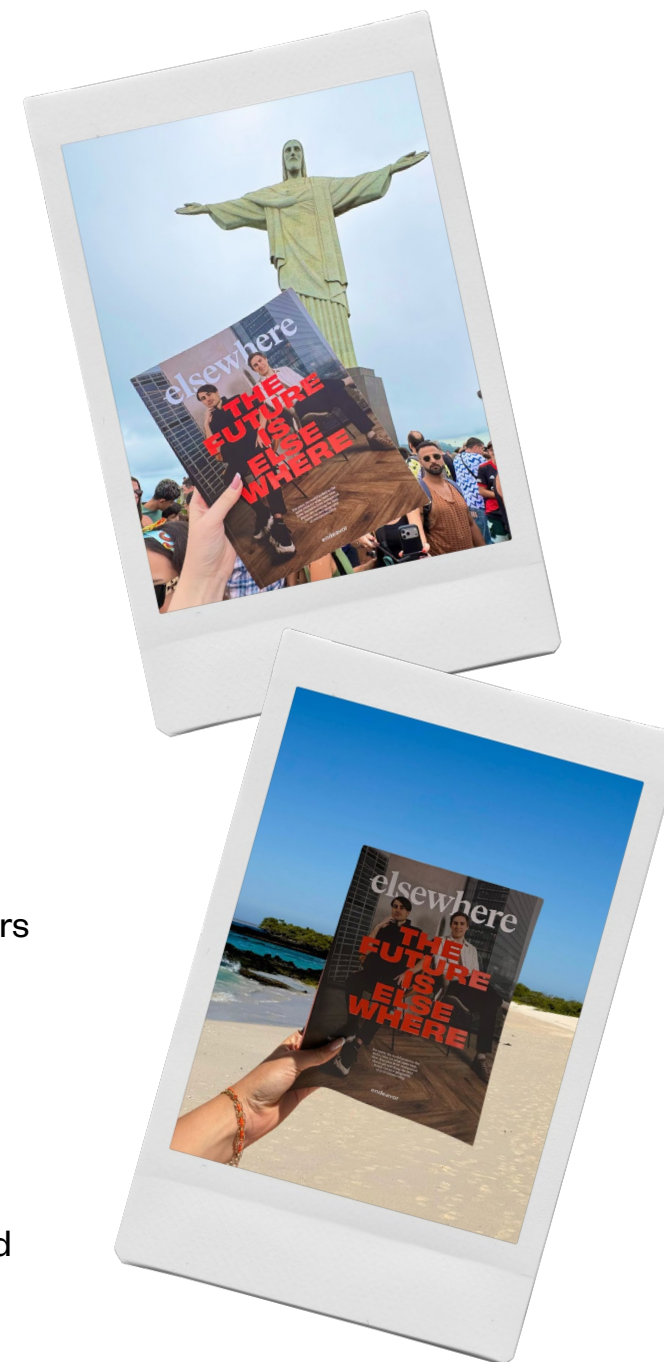

Why Endeavor decided to launch in New Zealand

Ten years ago, the best and brightest of New Zealand saw a clear path to success: leave. In pursuit of achievement in business, academia, and culture, Kiwis often felt they needed a stage larger than what New Zealand could offer. In a country known for resilience and self-sufficiency, the tyranny of distance and a small population have long left the economy trailing other Western nations. But a vibrant tech ecosystem could change this. The moment was ripe for a new phase of development, which is why we opened our 46th office in Auckland in 2025.

While New Zealand is only just emerging on the global entrepreneurial landscape, technology and entrepreneurship are offering new paths for high achievement and innovation that transcend local communities. Combined, they offer a path for Auckland to rapidly increase GDP/capita and return to the OECD's leading ranks as startup activity accelerates. We want to be there to support them.

Building Second Homes for Global Founders

As more founders build across borders, certain cities emerge as places where entrepreneurs go big, but also go home.

As founders increasingly build across borders, certain cities have become natural crossroads for global entrepreneurship. These are places where capital flows, industries converge, and ambitious founders from different regions meet.

Endeavor's Global Hubs are designed to support that movement. Each Hub creates a second home for diaspora founders building beyond their original markets, offering access to capital, networks, and new pathways to scale and liquidity. They also strengthen Endeavor's selection engine by connecting exceptional local founders with global mentors, investors, and operators.

Together, our global hubs form a connective tissue across our network, helping founders move faster between markets while staying rooted in the communities they came from.

LONDON

Endeavor's Global Hub in London serves entrepreneurs building across Europe, the Middle East, and Africa — including companies like ElevenLabs, born in Poland and now a decacorn; Proximie, a healthtech company from Lebanon enabling remote surgery through AR; and LemFi, a Nigerian fintech transforming cross-border payments for immigrants worldwide. Since launching in 2024, the hub has been led by Constanza Castro Feijóo and has already become home to more than 80 Endeavor Entrepreneurs from over 30 countries — a community whose impact compounds as successful founders go on to mentor, invest in, and open doors for the next generation.
